A. Introduction of State Interpreter: Lesley Loeb and Dee Pasternick
Char Heenan reviewed 2025 Rule Changes, and Points of Emphasis as well as positioning, aeriels, back of stick and more!

Char explained new info about the test and other things with Arbiter, explaining nothing we can do, do not shoot messenger, things will get better. Char asked who took the test, someone from arbiter made up the test without input and again will be better in the future
If you have taken the test have 10 tries but if you have not, notice went out today, two more are coming stressing deadline of taking test and being eligible for the fall season

dash vs. dot dash is a rule dot is a situation

Rules changes were discussed with Char asking all to correct in rulebook:

p 10 1-5-1f socks dark is home, visitor is white

1.5-1 Sit C switch home and visitor p16 dark home, visitor white long sleeve shirt color

1-6-5 p12 masks optional at hs level, removal of mask at completion of penalty corner- p13 wire cage mask must be removed, can wear goggles all over field, can wear plain form fitting facemark all over the field Penalty corner checklist-look for the wire mask and perhaps remind player with removing it at end of penalty corner Outside the 25yd line, wire mask is worn on the way there, remind player to remove, if not discarded on first stoppage of play, award the card

4-4-3 p29 no subs prior to penalty corner, sub can occur on completion of penalty corner and sub may occur prior to stroke

p47 Article 11 substitution may occur immediately following completion of the PC-fix in rule book

p29 4-4-7 suspended player must follow substitution rules during a corner

8-2-1 p39 goalkeeper suspended for uniform jersey violations, coach shall remove one field player for the suspension and goalie remains in game Prevent don't penalize so try to handle prior to start, but if during, take kid off not goalie but goalie gets green card

Be sure to check mouthguard, throat protector as goalie enters game, card goalie
11-2-7 p 51 End of game penalty corner/penalty stroke If one team ahead and
corner doesn't change outcome horn prior to insertion Do not pay out If prior to horn
sounding, corner is in play must complete End of game only
